

To the President of the United States.

Under the provisions of the following  
clause of Article Second of the treaty, this day  
~~concluded at La Pointe between the United States~~  
of Henry C. Gilbert and David B. Ferriman Com<sup>tee</sup>  
luly appointed for that purpose and the Chippewas  
of Lake Superior and the Mississippi viz:

"And being desirous to provide for some of  
his connections who have rendered his people imp-  
ortant services, it is agreed that the Chief Buffalo  
may select One Section of land at such place  
in the Ceded territory as he may see fit, which  
shall be reserved for that purpose and conveyed  
by the United States to such person or persons as  
he may direct."

I hereby Select a tract of land one mile  
Square, the exact boundary of which may be def-  
ined when the surveys are made, lying on the West  
Shore of St Louis Bay Minnesota Territory imme-  
diately above and adjoining Minnesota point, and I  
direct that patents be issued for the same according  
to the above recited provision to Shaw-baw-skung  
or Benjamin G. Armstrong my adopted son, to  
Matthew May dway gwon, my stepson, to Joseph  
May dway gwon and Catherine May dway gwon  
his sons - One quarter section to each.
